I understand the following:

- That this application is the property of FFHS.
- That by adopting an animal from an animal welfare organization, I take a certain risk. Although FFHS attempts to find compatible homes for each pet, the animal is adopted at the adopter's own risk and from this date forward, any damages to persons or property by this animal is the adopter's responsibility. FFHS will assist and advise adopters if problems arise.
- That FFHS will accept the animal if returned within three (3) days after the day of adoption if a veterinarian has determined the animal is unhealthy. In such case, the cost of the veterinary examination shall be borne by the ADOPTER, but the ADOPTER shall be entitled to a refund of the adoption fee.
- That after this three day period, the animal may still be returned to FFHS, **BUT THERE WILL BE NO REFUND OF THE ADOPTION FEE** or other costs incurred by the owner.
- That each animal has been screened for health and temperament issues to the best of the FFHS's ability in the time that it has been at the shelter.
- That FFHS will permanently reclaim the pet, if in the judgment of the FFHS, the home is unsuitable, if the animal has been neglected or abused, or if the adopter has misrepresented any facts to the FFHS.

FFHS will adopt animals to the general public without regard for race, religion, gender, national origin, physical or mental disability or veteran status of military service.
